This message is an update to the RMG-RIO Transition Message 1, dated 30 June 2014.

As we discussed in the previous transition ARCNet message, the BIMAA footprint that you're familiar with today is changing as we establish the Integration Cell within HQ RIO by December 2014. This new capability will enhance operations through service standardization.

The next phase of this transition is the shifting of BIMAA functions to the detachments. Therefore, effective 11 August 2014, BIMAA offices will close and you are directed to work with your unit reserve coordinator (URC) and, if required, then your servicing detachment.
