

Board and Board President Observations

- DT vectors/KPL/DE list not effective for board in decision making
- Stratification for IDE on applications
 - Many are 1 of 1 or 1 of 2 at Wing or similar level
 - How do we get better stratification
- DT not ready for use in RDEDB
 - Vectors are up to a year old and no longer correct
 - Members meeting RDEDB did not meet DT due to filtering
- Further guidance to board on what to look at from HQ
 - DT vectors?
 - DE KPL and DE
 - Top 20 / PV
 - CMB decisions
