Nomination packages for the Air Force General John P. Jumper Award for Excellence in Warfighting Integration and the Annual Information Dominance Professionals of the Year Awards for FY16 are due to your servicing HQ RIO Detachment by Sept. 30, 2016.

The General Jumper award recognizes individuals for sustained superior performance and outstanding contributions to the integration of Air Force or DoD warfighting and/or operations support capabilities that shorten the kill chain and/or enhance the decision cycle. There are three categories for this award: officer (0-1 - 0-5), enlisted (E-1 - E-8), and civilian (GS-01-GS-14). Winners from each category will go on to compete for Air Force Association's General Billy Mitchell Award for C4 Excellence.

The Information Dominance awards recognize USAF military members (officers and enlisted), federal civilian employees, teams, and units for sustained superior performance while providing information dominance and cyberspace operations to Air Force and/or DoD missions and operations. There are several categories for this award: individual awards (officer, enlisted, civilian, various career fields; i.e. 3A1XX, 3D0XX, CGO, Airman, NCO, etc.), team award (General Edwin W. Rawlings Team Award), and unit awards (Maj. Gen. Harold M. McClelland Award, Lt. Gen. Harold W. Grant Award). Additional details on these award categories are available in AFI 36-2845.
