The comprehensive curriculum guides students through the intricacies of managing the mobility enterprise in contingency and humanitarian operations.* The DIRMOBFOR course is a pre-requisite for those wishing to be considered for DIRMOBFOR and Deputy DIRMOBFOR positions worldwide. Historically, AMC has selected graduated and sitting wing commanders, vice wing commanders and operations group commanders to fill DIRMOBFOR and Deputy DIRMOBFOR positions in the CENTCOM AOR. AMC utilizes a more liberal approach selecting the DIRMOBFOR positions for humanitarian operations and exercises. In addition, airdrop experience has been preferred.

*18 AF provides DIRMOBFOR/LNOs to Geographic Combatant Commands (GCCs) and supports exercises throughout all areas of responsibility (AORs). To provide AOR specific expertise, 18 AF utilizes a "Bench" concept consisting of two officers each from AD, AFRC and ANG assigned to specific GCCs for two-year periods. These officers are afforded additional opportunities to enhance DIRMOBFOR experience/knowledge through participation in annual AOR exercises. If selected to attend, AFRC's DIRMOBFOR course graduates will be assigned a GCC, are expected to participate in AOR specific exercises and fill potential AFRC taskings/requirements to include deployments.

Class Dates: 8 - 12 February 2016 (7 and 13 February are Travel Days) Location: Hurlburt Field, FL This course is centrally funded for MAs, IMAs, TRs, and ARTs attending in military status and unit funded for all others.
