Even if you're still not exactly sure of the dates, you must submit your AT request. If your dates change, that's OK. We can modify the request. The important part is to lock down the funding so it's there at the end of the FY for you to perform duty.

FY16 Loss Management Procedure:

AFRC past experiences, current recruiting challenges and review of AFRC reaching end strength goals has dictated they must retain as many personnel as possible through the end of the fiscal year. Therefore, voluntary and involuntary reassignments to the Individual Ready Reserve (IRR), retirements and voluntary and involuntary discharges from the Selected Reserve approved between 1 Feb 16-30 Sep 16 must have an effective loss date no earlier than 1 Nov 16.

This procedure does not apply to the following:

- Transfer to any active duty component
- Transfer to any AGR or EAD tour
- Transfer within the Unit or IMA Program
- Transfer between the Unit or Ima Program
- Transfer to IRR based on elapsed ETS with remaining MSO
- Separation at ETS
- Retirements at ETS
- Retirement at HYTD, MSD or age 60
- Conditional release to transfer to ANG
- Colonels
- AGRs

IR Spotlight

Our Det 6 IMA spotlight is on MSgt Stephen Tao: He enlisted in the Hawaii Air National Guard in May 1994 as a member of the 154th Security Police Squadron. He loved being a Security Policeman and stayed in that career field for five years, stating that it was a challenging but rewarding.
