From the Commander:

From the Det 6 team, I hope you all had a safe and festive holiday



season. As we begin 2018, I encourage you all to take some time to set some personal and professional goals for the year (aka "resolutions"). Of course, you can do that any time, but the beginning of the year has a spirit of renewal about it that tends to provide some momentum. Among my goals for the year are to a) run every single day in January and b) finish my Project Management Professional (PMP) certification. The years go by fast so we should strive to continuously grow, and I like to use New Year's resolutions (goals) as an impetus to keep that up through the year.

Blended Retirement System (BRS) Acknowledgement/Training:

Many of you have received multiple emails and ARCNet messages regarding the legal requirement for Reservists at certain year marks to a) acknowledge being informed about the opt-in/opt out decision on the new Blended Retirement System and b) take the ADLS training on the BRS. If you received those messages, you are required to do both. This is a legal requirement and AFRC is being scrutinized for its completion percentage. I'm fairly confident we will end up having to go down the road to a no-pay/no-points status in the near future to get this requirement completed, and I can almost guarantee that it will happen at the most inconvenient and inopportune moment that will prevent you from coming to duty. So get it done if you're supposed to. It's only 10-ish minutes.

The Chaos and Mayhem of Continuing Resolutions

As I write this, we are in a CR until 19 January, and HQ RIO does not have funding for Annual Tour orders that start in 2 duty days. And no one knows if we'll get funding for those AT orders. And OBTW, this same scenario plays out every time Congress incrementally funds the DoD for a few weeks. We have operated under a CR for 13 out of the last 15 years, with 2-4 CRs every year. Imagine how it feels to tell an IMA who's been planning to perform duty months in advance that 2 days before that duty you don't know if they can perform it. That's the situation Det 6 and our IMAs find ourselves in for the 4th time in the past 12 months.

We all know this is no way to run a railroad. From the military's point of view, our senior leaders have testified before Congress time and time again about how disruptive CRs are, yet here we are. I don't have any good advice except to please bear with us and remain flexible.
