Actual Expense Authorizations Due to Admin Error

IRs who received an inaccurate lodging rate through a Commercial Travel Office (CTO), that exceeds the maximum allowable rate can request approval of payment for the excess amount by obtaining an Actual Expense Authorization (AEA) letter from the Defense Travel System (DTS) and completing the following steps:

1. Contact the CTO to obtain written confirmation that an error was made by the CTO

 Forward the completed AEA letter along with CTO confirmation to Det 6/IRPP: <u>RIODET6@US.AF.MIL</u> for the Det 6/CC approval
Once you have received the approved AEA, upload a copy along with CTO email confirmation to DTS to file your travel voucher

Delay in Reserve Payment

End of the year closeout is now complete; however there is still a significant delay in reserve pay processing. HQ RIO Reserve Pay office is still requesting 20 business days for processing of your pay documents and another 15 business days for DFAS to release payment. New Chip and PIN Government Travel Charge Cards

Chip and PIN is the next generation of payment card technology and is being introduced as another tool to combat potential fraud. Starting in mid-January 2015, only chip and PIN travel charge cards will be issued to DoD personnel to include qualified new applicants and individuals reporting their card lost/stolen.
