

ANG TO IMA PROCESSING ACTIONS

1. Member contacts an AFR recruiter who will work with the RIO DET on assignment selection/approval.
2. Following RIO DET selection/approval, member notified to initiate his/her ANG separation process via MvFSS through his/her Chain of Command for the Air Component Transfer. Member should provide the separation ID to the RIO DET & N AFR Recruiter (as proof of initiation).
3. Member coordinates AF1288 with recruiter and losing chain of command.
4. RIO DET submits approved AF1288, any add'l source documents and the MyFSS Separations ID and/or Casefile number to ARPC/DPAAA via MyVector.
5. ARPC/DPAAA receives MyVector application and will suspense/monitor the member's separation processing in MyFSS.
6. Losing ANG FSS will initiate a MyFSS application to ARPC Guard Separations for separation actions, ANG discharge order, NGB22 and MILPDS projection.
7. ARPC/DPAAA will provide information/updates on the separation actions to the RIO DET via the MvVector application.
8. ARPC ANG Separations will complete the MILPDS loss projection and ANG Discharge orders/NGB22 and communicate completed actions via ANG Separation TEAMS channel.
9. ARPC/DPAAA retrieves source documents and performs MilPDS gain actions into IMA assignment.
10. ARPC/DPAAA will upload source documents and communicate with RIO DET once assignment actions are complete via RIO DET generated MyVector ticket. MyVector application will be closed.
