ARPC Notice: 250701-01

Topic: Eligibility for the Reserve Component Survivor Benefit Plan (RCSBP)

Impact: Air National Guard and Air Force Reserve Airmen

BLUF: Starting 1 August 2025, when you complete the service requirements for Reserve retired pay, you will become eligible for the Reserve Component Survivor Benefit Plan (RCSBP).

ARPC Notice: 250701-02

Topic: Shortage of DD Form 363AF, Certificate of Retirement

Impact: Air Force Reserve and Air National Guard

BLUF: : ARPC is currently experiencing a shortage of DD Forms 363AF, Certificate of Retirement.

ARPC Notice: 250701-03

Topic: TSA phasing out Uniformed Service IDs

Impact: Air Force Reserve and Air National Guard

BLUF: Starting in Fall 2025, the TSA is expected to phase out Uniformed Service IDs (USIDs) as acceptable identification at airport checkpoints due to new government policies. However, Common Access Cards (CACs) will continue to be accepted.
