Topic: Service Verification/DD Form 214 Systems Transition

Applicable to: Air National Guard and Air Force Reserve Airmen

BLUF: Service Verification/DD Form 214 Requests are **now available** on myFSS. Incidents already submitted within myPers will continue to be processed in myPers.

Effective **immediately**, members may utilize myFSS to submit a Reserve Service Verification / DD Form 214 request. However, starting **10 March 2023**, all requests must be submitted in myFSS. Due to the myPers sunset, any applications submitted in myPers after 10 March 2023 will need to be returned to the member to submit through myFSS. In an effort to reduce processing times during the 10-day transition, members should not submit duplicate requests (i.e. one in myPers and one in myFSS).

To submit a request, navigate to the [myFSS landing page](#) and enter the title of the Knowledge Article into the Knowledge Article search bar located at the top of the page.

Starting 1 March 2023, members may utilize myFSS to submit a Reserve Separations request. However, starting **10 March 2023**, all requests must be submitted through myFSS. Due to the myPers sunset, applications will not be able to be accepted in myPers after 10 March 2023. In an effort to reduce processing times during this transition period, members should not submit duplicate requests (i.e. - one in myPers and one in myFSS).
