Topic: myFSS Reduced Retired Pay Age (RRPA) Application Updates and Feedback

Applicable to: Air National Guard and Air Force Reserve Airmen

BLUF: Air Force Reserve and Air National Guard members will not need to attach qualifying orders unless there is a discrepancy in data or the RRPA Application reflects “Potentially Qualifying” on the Orders/PCARS line.

The myFSS RRPA application is linked with AROWS-R/G and automatically determines periods of service that qualify/do not qualify. This saves time for both service members and ARPC retirement technicians. As a result, service members can submit the initial RRPA application without attaching orders. Once ARPC reviews and confirms, service members can review and attach qualifying orders for periods of service that still reflect "Potentially Qualifying."

In 2015, the Chief of the Air Force Reserve authorized Reserve Airmen in certain Headquarters positions to receive RRPA credit. These service members' Extended Active-Duty orders were amended to Title 10 USC 12731 and ARPC technicians manually updated their vPC/Remedy RRPA applications. Unfortunately, during the migration from vPC/Remedy to myFSS, these updates did not take and these periods of service in myFSS RRPA applications now reflect "Non-Qualifying".

The team at ARPC has identified the impacted members and will update each member's RRPA Application. Members approaching retirement that notice this discrepancy can attach the initial order/amendment and resubmit the RRPA application. We appreciate your patience as we manually correct each member's application.

Many additional enhancements of the RRPA Application are currently pending and will be seen within the RRPA application in the coming months.
