Topic: Systems Transferring Away from myPers

Impact: Air National Guard and Air Force Reserve Airmen

BLUF: Several remaining personnel programs are transitioning to new systems and will no longer be available on myPers beginning 1 April 2023.

The personnel programs transitioning to myFSS include Reserve Service Programs, IRR PIM Readiness, Education Services, AFR Bonuses and Incentives and IR Classification and Training.

The personnel programs transitioning to MyVector include Joint Officer Management, AFR Developmental Education, AFR Developmental Teams, Key Command and Joint, AFR Assignments and ANG Assignments.

During this transition, members may experience a slight delay in processing of case inquiries. Please ensure they consider these potential delays when making requests that may affect promotion, development, or benefits.

Topic: Accessions System Transition

Impact: Air Force Reserve Airmen

BLUF: As of 7 April 2023, all accessions related requests should be submitted through MyVector. Incidents already submitted within myPers will continue to be processed in myPers.

Effective 7 April 2023, members will utilize MyVector to submit Non-EAD Line Commissioning (formerly Deserving Airmen program) packages, Competitive Category Changes, Core ID changes, Appointment Order Questions and General Accessions Inquiries.

To submit a request, navigate to the MyVector landing page and navigate to Applications on the left-hand side. Then choose Accessions and the applicable category.

During this transition, members may experience a slight delay in processing of case inquiries. Please ensure they consider these potential delays when making requests that may affect promotion, development, or benefits.
