BLUF: Reserve Separations Requests are now available on myFSS.

Effective immediately, Air Force Reserve members must utilize myFSS to submit Reserve Separations Requests. Incidents submitted through myPers will no longer be accepted and will need to be submitted through myFSS.

To submit a request, navigate to the <u>myFSS landing page</u> and enter the title of the Knowledge Article into the Knowledge Article search bar located at the top of the page.
