A method to assess the maturity level of lines of production (LOP), or transactional activities, across ARPC. LOPs are identified and prioritized by each directorate based upon the various products provided to the more than 1 million customers served by ARPC. The levels of maturity uncertified, bronze, silver, and gold. The DPH directorate has created an assessment checklist that is assigned to the LOP leads. LOP leads must answer questions and complete artifacts such as a Gemba board. process map, standard work, leader standard work, and training milestones to prove the sustainment of their LOP.

- 2 of 42 LOPs achieve bronze certification (March 2025)

- LOP Gold Model Cell established (September 2025)

- Outbrief and report for each LOP that has achieved bronze, silver, or gold certification
