SUBJECT: CY22 1N & 9S ISR Career Field Enlisted Key Personnel List (KPL)

1. I am pleased to announce the results of the CY22 AFRC Intelligence (1N & 9S) Career Field Developmental Team (DT) Board. The board convened 21-25 March 2022, at Headquarters Air Reserve Personnel Center (ARPC), Buckley AFB, CO. The board panel, consisted of five total force ISR Chief Master Sergeants and two Senior Master Sergeants. Panel members evaluated 250 records for vectoring and development for the ranks of Technical Sergeant through Chief Master Sergeant. These efforts resulted in the selection of 61 Airmen for the CY22 AFRC 1N & 9S Career Field KPL.
2. Selection for the KPL indicates a member is highly competitive in their career field and grade based on the whole person concept, and is therefore seen as a High Potential Leader, which may lead to specific opportunities and development as future senior AFR leaders. While placement on the KPL does not guarantee anyone a job, hiring authorities for designated key positions do reference this list when making hiring decisions.

These members have demonstrated leadership by completing above and beyond training requirements, developmental education, gained experience, and fostered advancement of Airmen and the mission.
