SUBJECT: O-5 Key/Command/JDAL (K/C/J) Position Management

- 1. Headquarters Air Reserve Personnel Center (ARPC) is pleased to announce the formation of a new Key/Command/Joint Duty Assignment Listing (JDAL) Management Branch. This new office will directly assist in placing Key Personnel Listing (KPL) officers, as recognized by career field Developmental Teams, and in-residence developmental education (DE) students into O-5 Key, Command, or JDAL positions. K/C/J positions make up roughly 3% of available field grade officer positions in the Air Force Reserve.
- 2. The K/C/J Branch will implement guidance set forth in AFRCI 36-2640 *Executing Air Force Reserve Force Development* related to the deliberate management of K/C/J positions. These positions are intended as 3-year tour lengths (and 4 years for JDAL assignments) to intentionally develop the Air Force Reserve's next generation of leaders. Initially, this office will only focus on O-5 AGR, TR, and RIO Detachment 6 & 7 IMA K/C/J positions, and may expand to other ranks in the future. The K/C/J Management Branch will work closely with identified KPL officers, and currently assigned K/C/J position incumbents and their units to help manage K/C/J positions.
- 3. The management of K/C/J positions will require the timely reassignment of personnel currently occupying these positions beyond the 3- or 4-year recommended term limit. For those members currently serving beyond recommended term limits, this office will work closely with each member, providing no less than 12-months' notice of potential for reassignment, to identify reassignment opportunities and provide guidance on the extension request process to remain in the position.
- 4. For KPL members who have not served in a K/C/J position, the K/C/J Management Branch will contact each member to discuss availability/desire to serve in a K/C/J position. All qualified Reserve members are open to apply for these positions; however, priority consideration will be given to graduating in-residence DE students and designated KPL officers. All officers selected to fill a K/C/J position are required to sign a 3-year tour of duty Statement of Understanding

(SOU) for Key and Command positions, and 4-year SOU for JDAL positions regardless of KPL status.

5. Throughout the assignment lifecycle, the K/C/J Management Branch will maintain close communication with Career Field Managers, position incumbents, and owning units as a resource for all K/C/J matters.
