The federal civilian workforce makes up the largest demographic here

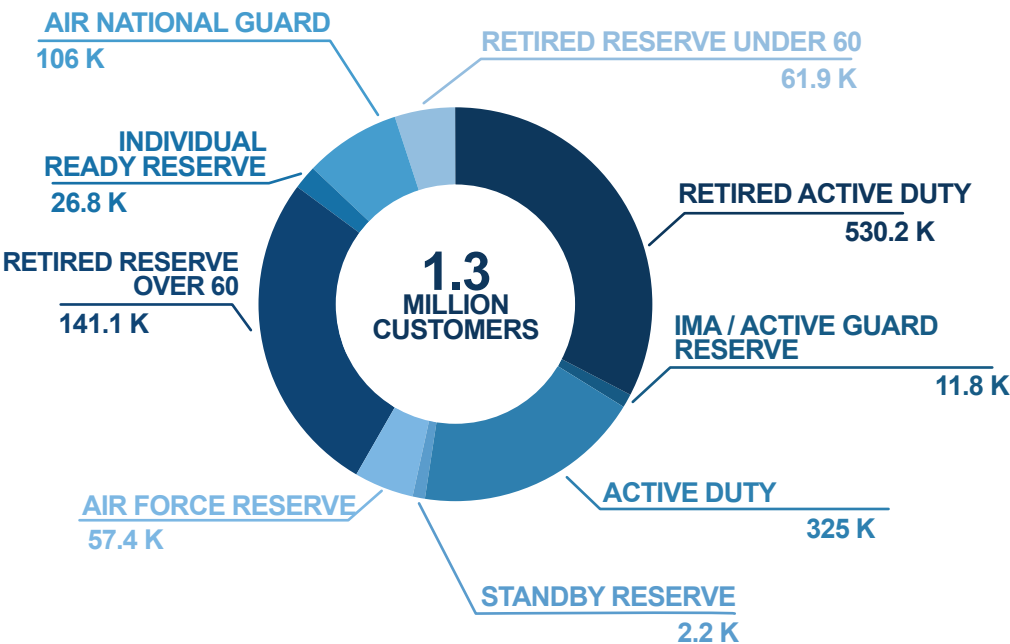
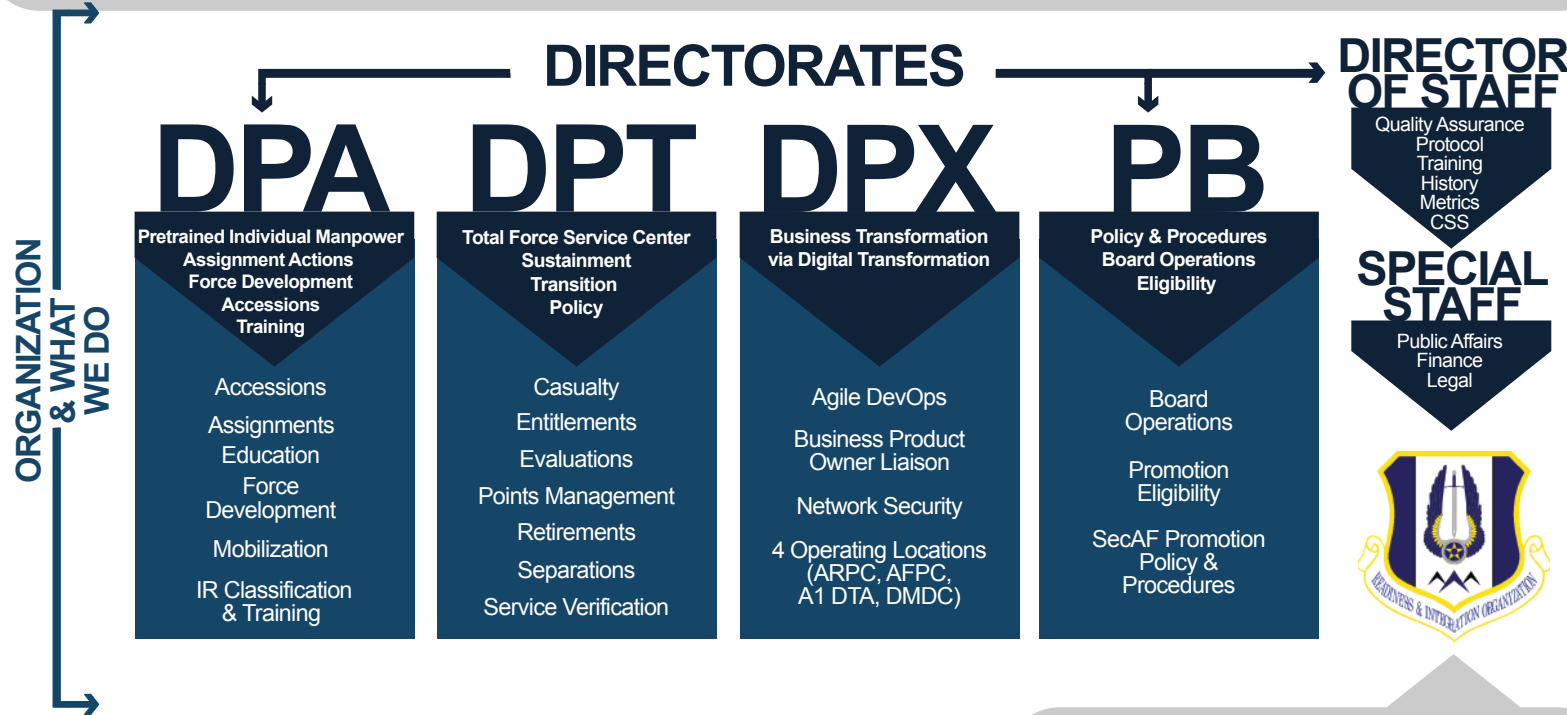
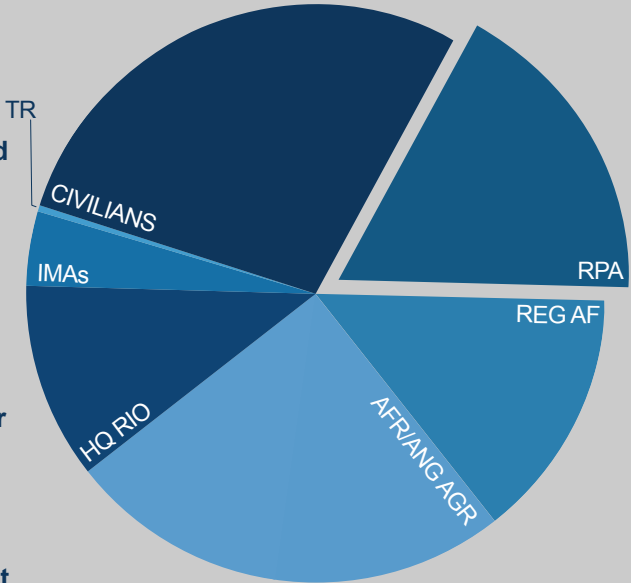
**AFR/ANG AGR 131**
