# **ABOUT HQ RIO**

Headquarters Individual Reservist Readiness and Integration Organization is located within the Headquarters Air Reserve Personnel Center at Buckley Air Force Base, Colorado. It is responsible for managing the Individual Reserve (IR) force and standardizing the processes needed to get them to the fight. The seven RIO detachments and six operating locations around the world assist in this mission, providing direct oversight and support to more than 8,400 IR Airmen.

## **ABOUT THE INDIVIDUAL RESERVE**

The **Individual Reserve (IR)** is comprised of Individual Mobilization Augmentees (IMA) and Participating Individual Ready Reservists (PIRR). The active-component organizations and government agencies to which these Reserve Citizen Airmen are assigned maintain operational control of these Airmen, while HQ RIO and the IR owning organization share administrative control.

The IR program offers many benefits to reservists, including increased flexiblity, the ability to serve alongside active-component service members, career-broadening opportunities such as joint duty assignment list, National-Capitol Region and higher headquarters assignments, and access to many benefits available to traditional reservists like MWR, TRICARE and Space A travel. IRs are also able to volunteer for MPA and RPA opportunities.

**IMA** | Category B reservist assigned to augment an active-component organization or government agency; participate for pay and points; must complete 12 days of annual tour and either 24 or 48 inactive duty training periods each year.

**PIRR** | Category E reservist assigned to augment an active-component organization; participate for points towards retirement only, though they are eligible for paid MPA and RPA opportunities; must complete 50 points-only inactive duty training periods each year.




# BENEFITS AND VACANCY INFORMATION


- Perform 12 or 24 IDTs, plus 12 days annual tour
- Create a custom duty schedule with your active-component supervisor
- Receive the same benefits as Traditional Reservists: TRICARE Reserve Select,
   Tuition Assistance, Space A travel, Commissary, BX and MWR facilities
- Opportunities to augment on a full-time basis via MPA or RPA funding


# IR AUTHORIZATIONS BY DETACHMENT
